The De Silva wines likewise get their character from very old vines planted in very distinctive soils. The wines of I Vigneti are made from younger vines (considered old by normal standards) and embody the family's philosophy of uncompromising care in both the vineyards and the cellar.

### Mariano del Friuli Isonzo

The Gallo family has been making wine in Isonzo for over 60 years. In the 1970's, Silvano Gallo redirected the focus of the estate towards quality, instituting the use of stainless steel tanks for fermentation in the winery, temperature control to preserve fruit character, and minimal handling of the wines to express terroir. Experimentation with different spacing methods, trellising and clones has translated into wines with riper and more concentrated fruit flavors. Fabrizio comments, "The potential for quality is given by the grapes, but then the winemaking has to express it. Both work together and it's a combination of the two which leads to great wine." Silvano's sons, Fabrizio and Marco, have taken over the vineyard and winemaking responsibilities after graduating from the school of Enology in Udine. With the ideas of a new generation, the estate is competing with the top producers of the region.

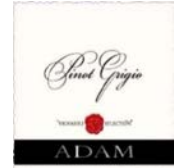

### Az. Agr. Lorenzo Begali

Cengia- San Pietro in Cariano



Begali is a family-run winery producing a total of 1,000 cases. The vineyards cover 18 acres in the rolling hills of a commune of Valpolicella, called Cengia. The name Cengia translates to ledges, and is derived from the physical appearance of these Alpine foothills. The vines are planted in a specific area known as Ca' Bianca. The winery was started after World War II when grandfather Giordano began to produce wine from the region's native grape varieties – Corvina, Corvinone, Rondinella and Molinara. It was his son, Lorenzo, together with his wife Adriana - the current owners of the winery - who started to market the wine in 1986. Today, their children Giordano and Tiliana play active roles in the winery.

#### Oltrepo' Pavese



The villa and property (now 64 acres) have been in the Odero family since 1919, and they have been producing and bottling their own wine there ever since. In the 1930s Giorgio Odero had already vinified the grapes from the different vineyards separately, choosing only the best crus; a rare practice in the area where most wine was mass-produced. They began exporting their wine to the United States in 1934, just after the end of the Prohibition, and today they still use their National Export Institute number 19 (there are now several thousand). In 1990, under the direction of Margherita Radici Odero, the vineyards were replanted and the cellar restructured with the latest technical improvements, and they began promoting the estate trademark in Italy and abroad. Under the estate's current direction by son-in-law Pietro Calvi di Bergolo, the wines are being described as some of the best from Oltrepó.

A small, 12 acre vineyard located in the heart of Barolo, the Scarzello estate has a long and impressive history. Since its very beginning some three-hundred years ago, having been one of the only estates not owned by the extremely powerful Marchese Falletto (the grandfather of the Barolo wine), Scarzello has prided itself on its independence and its individuality. This tradition continues in full-force today, as the property remains family-owned and operated just as it has been for the past eight generations. The current winemaker and oenologist is Federico Scarzello. Using mostly traditional cultivation and wine-making techniques, with a few modern exceptions, Federico continues to improve the quality of the wines and to preserve the acclaim of the vineyard. His 1999 Barolo 'Vigna Merenda' brought the family its first Tre Bicchieri award. Vigna Merenda is a "monopole" of the Scarzello family within the Sarmassa cru.

Opportunely placed to benefit from excellent exposure to southern sunlight and glancing breezes, the vines are robust and distinctive, ranging from 15 to 60 years old. The wines of the San Giuliano estate are expressive of the passion and deep personal involvement that goes into their creation.
